In addition to the NMB, seventeen other high school bands will perform today. It will take all hands on deck to make this event a success! We ask that at least one adult from each marching band family volunteer—sign up at normalmb.org. We also ask that all who are affiliated with the NMB park in the Carle BroMenn parking lot A, to the south of the Resale Boutique Thrift Shop. (Cars may not park at the IWU Shirk Center, Tucci Stadium, or BroMenn Hospital.)

Invite friends, family, neighbors, and teachers to come to our show! It is a great opportunity for them to see what we have been working on!

At competitions, it is customary for the host band to perform in "exhibition," meaning that we will not be competing at this event. We will, however, be adjudicated and will receive feedback from the panel of outstanding adjudicators. This feedback will help us improve throughout the season.

Do you know where/when to report for your shift? Remember to wear your show shirt! Color Guard rehearsal at Normal West. (Team lunch beforehand?)

Change into uniform, prepare for the show. The directors, staff, and parent volunteers will be running the Invitational, so the student leadership team will help make this happen! Be sure to manage hair responsibilities on your own as best you can, since hair help will be limited.

In uniform by the truck, ready for inspection and physical warm up.

Depart for Warm Up Areas.
