5:15 PM

6:00 PM

6:25 PM

March to the Stadium (Eighth Grade Musicians and HS Musicians)

The high school band will perform the National Anthem prior to the game, and the eighth grade musicians will join on the field for the home team's starting lineup tunnel.

During the game, we invite eighth grade parents to join the high school parents in the bleachers. (There is generally a group near the top, behind the band.)

All Musicians will play pep music in the bleachers

Eighth Graders will have the opportunity to see the NMB Competition Show during halftime.

We expect the evening to end between 9:30 and 10:30 PM, depending on the pace of the game. Students may call or text for a ride at the end of the evening.
